The purpose of the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course is to teach candidates the knowledge and skills needed to prevent and respond to aquatic emergencies. The course content and activities prepare candidates to recognize and respond quickly and effectively to emergencies and prevent drowning and injuries.

Successful completion requires 100% attendance and participation in skills practice. The practice sessions will require some strenuous physical activity. If a medical condition or disability exists that might prevent participation in the activities, or there are questions about fully participating in the Lifeguarding course, please contact me to discuss this before the course begins.

To **enroll** in the Lifeguarding course, you must be at **least 15 years of age** before the last scheduled class session. To **participate** in the Lifeguarding course, you must be able to demonstrate the following skills in a **PreCourse Skills Test** :

1. Swim 500 yards continuously, using the front crawl and breaststroke, demonstrating rhythmic breathing.
2. Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs.
3. Starting in the water, swim 20 yards using front crawl or breaststroke, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10 pound object, return to the surface, swim 20 yards back to the starting point with the object and exit the water without using a ladder or steps, within 1 minute, 40 seconds. Goggles are not allowed for this event.

Age confirmation and skills evaluation will happen on Friday, April 20th at 5:00pm. Please bring a valid ID as proof of age, a swimsuit, and towel for the PreCourse Skills test and for every class.

Upon successful completion of the Lifeguarding course, each participant will receive an American Red Cross International Certificate indicating Lifeguarding / First Aid / CPR-AED for the Professional Rescuer.
